

SETUP and USE of REMOTE REQUEST TOOL

Connect crossover cable between PC and Laptop or use wireless set up.

Note: A connection must be in place

Note: You must start on Host PC first

On the Host computer:

- In Swift Elite - Go to preference – Go to “Start Up Options” – click on “Start Remote Request Tool” (This turns on the Server) Minimize this box

On the Laptop:

- Create a folder on the Desk Top called “Swift Elite Remote Folder”. Put inside that folder: “A file from the Host PC called “Collections.mdb” (From inside C:\Program files\Swift Elite 3) This will consist of the entire collection of songs that are in the Swift Elite collection. (This file “Collections.mdb” must be updated weekly or “Remote Tool Client” will not find songs that are newly entered into the collection or modified).
- Put a copy of RemoteTool.exe inside that folder. Use that exe file to open “Remote Tools Client”
- When you open the Remote Tools program on the Laptop a menu from inside that folder, (Remote Tools Client – Sessions) comes up. Click on “Start Search”, when it finds something click on “Join”.
- A remote tool client box comes up. Click the box for the type of files you want to search for. Also choose if you want the songs sent to player A or player B.
- Minimize this box (do not close it)
- Note: To close the program, it is this box you close to shut down not the large program showing on the screen.
- Note: To see the name in the playlist go to Edit Items and select “Enter Singers Name” to toggle on.
